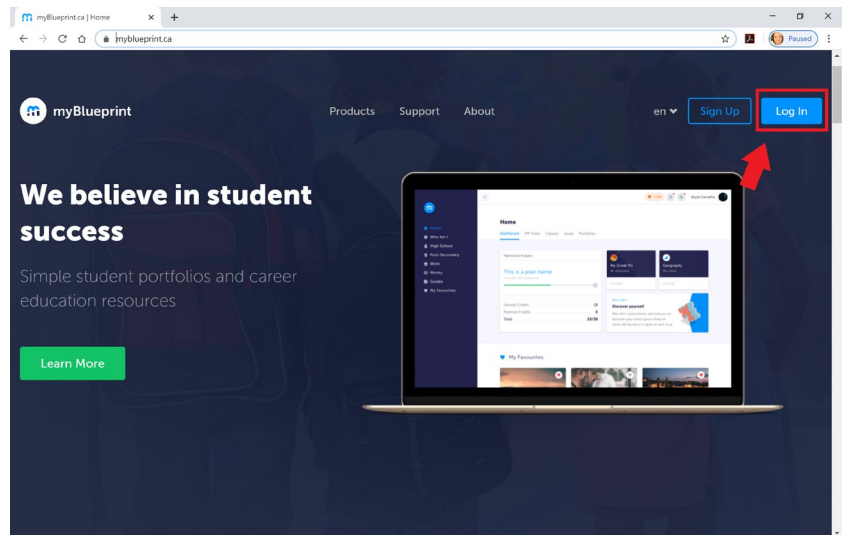


myBlueprint SD42 Student Login

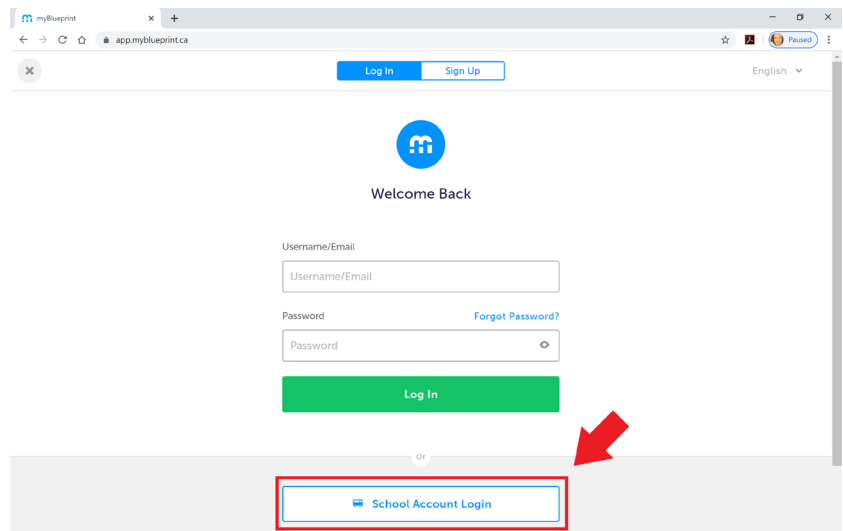
This tutorial is intended to guide a student of SD42 through the steps of logging into myBlueprint.

Note: there is an option to log in using a QR Code, but this is beyond the scope of this tutorial.


1. Open your preferred browser. [Note: I could not find a list of supported browsers. If something does not seem to work as expected, try a different browser.]
2. Navigate to <https://myblueprint.ca/>. [Note: you can also navigate to <https://myblueprint.ca/sd42>, click on “School Account Log In” button and skip to step 7 below.]
3. Click “Log In” button.



4. Click “School Account Login” button. [Note: you may have to scroll down to see this option. Sometimes this is not obvious.]




5. Select "SD42 Maple Ridge" in the "School District/School" dropdown.

6. Click "Login with School Account" button.

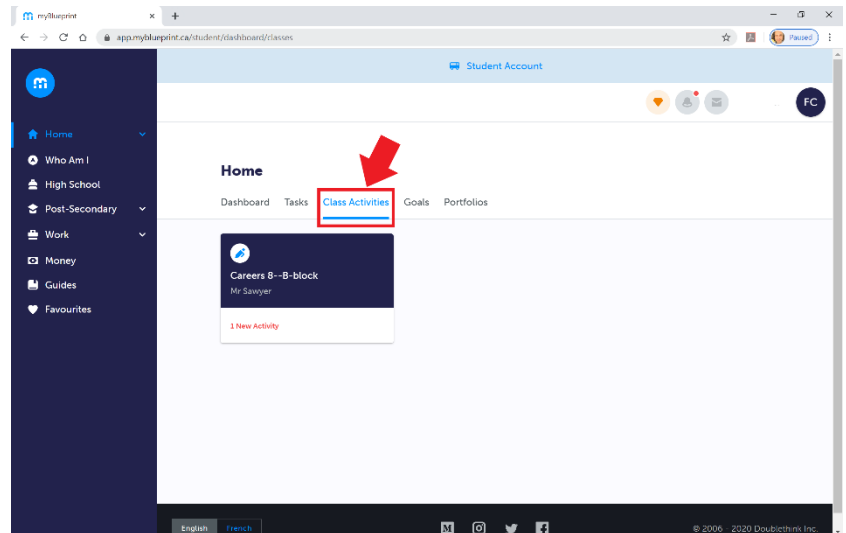

7. Sign in using your district login credentials.
 - a. Type your student number into the “firstname_lastname@mrpm.sd42.ca” box. [Note: after you type your student number and move the cursor to the password box, “@mrpm.sd42.ca” will be added automatically.]
 - b. Type your district password into the “Password” box.
 - c. Click the “Sign in” button.
